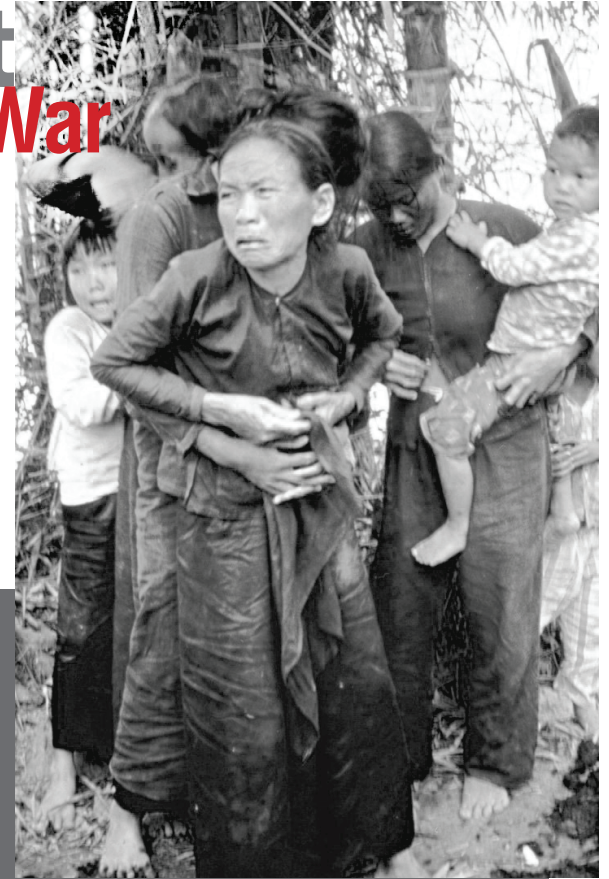
## A memorial to the victims of American War
