A number of files can be found under `~mm3572/unix07/olympics`. These files are related to the olympic games. The file named "years" lists the years and locations of the Olympic games. Each of the other files gives information about one olympic sport.

For each of the following questions, the answer should be given as a single sequence of piped Unix commands. Only the commands described in the first 9 lectures excluding awk (sed is included). The answers should be given in a single ascii file, which is what you will turn in.

0. Browse all the files.
1. Print the year and location of the last ten games excluding the five most recent.
